## 2008 Central European Summer School for Conflict Resolution CESS-CR o8

The training takes place over 8 days from August 31<sup>st</sup> to September 7<sup>th</sup>.

### Curriculum

The language of instruction is English. Interactive translation among participants is encouraged. First-time participants will experience and learn to conduct Community-based Conflict Resolution CBCR foundational processes. Returning participants will practise advanced process leadership skills, as well as prepare and lead a public community dialogue.

### Trainers

Dr. Hania M. Fedorowicz, M.A., Director of the European Institute for CBCR, is leading the summer session. Assistant trainer is Mag. Dora Gmeiner-Jahn. Further training support: Mag. Marko Iršič and Mag. Jerzy Rębecki.

Every returning participant is required to attach to the registration a short documentation of the activities led or co-led since the last Summer School (field process or selected CBCR processes).

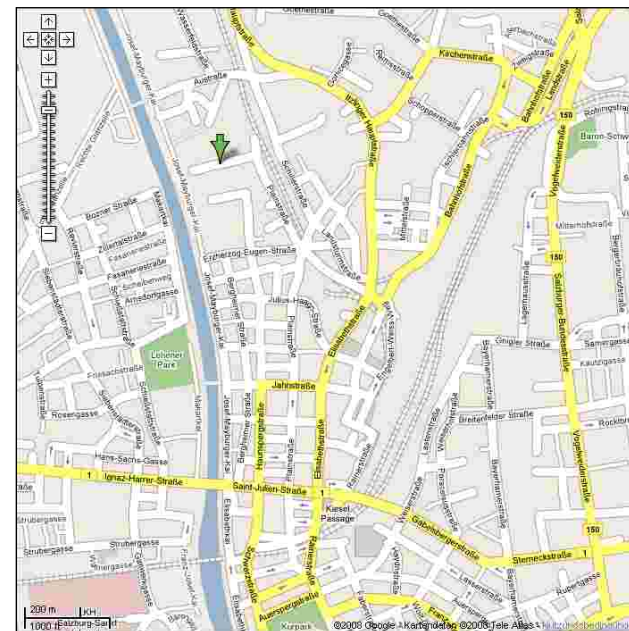
