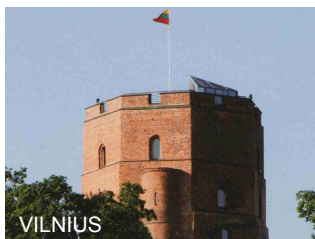

Summer school programme

The training will enable participants to understand identity and other conflict dynamics, to improve social and communicative competences and to learn the use of new tools to deal with interpersonal, social and political conflict constructively. The pedagogy used is practical and experiential, and aims to transfer methods and practices to new settings.

A highlight of the week is a public community dialogue, the Vilnius Dialogue for Europe, structured as a large group mediation. The dialogue will be lead by participants of the summer school, as a practicum to implement the leadership skills and conflict-resolving formats learned in the summer school. Training will take place over 7 days in English. Interactive translation among participants is encouraged.

Follow-up cooperation, further projects and networking between participants and partners is strongly recommended.

Co-Trainers

Dr. Hania M. Fedorowicz, M.A., Director of the European Institute for CBCR, and Mag. Dorothea Gmeiner-Jahn, are leading the LECORES project.

Costs of participation NEW

International participants pay a nominal training fee of 250 EUR and cover the costs of their own travel. Accommodation is provided free of charge by local partners.

The training location is at Mykolas Romeris university in Vilnius, the capital of Lithuania. Vilnius can be reached by bus, train or plane.
